HCC Youth Director Job Description

The HCC Youth Director is responsible for coordinating events and activities for the youth of HCC, grades 6 – 12, in connection with the school year. The HCC Youth Director should ideally have some experience working with teens in a church capacity, and preferably some prior experience working in an international environment. The person who takes this position should commit to the position for a minimum of one school year. Vacation time should be scheduled parallel to the school vacation of the youth to ensure that the Youth Director is available throughout the school year. Vacation should be scheduled in agreement with the leadership team or senior pastor.

One can expect to dedicate the majority of your time to this position. This includes prayer, study and planning, communication, mentoring, and discipleship, as well as actual time with the larger group of youth and committed youth group leaders. If the person applying for this position is involved in another ministry or job, they should be able to give at least 20 hours a week to the youth group. The Youth Director should raise his/her own financial support; however HCC may be able to provide some financial assistance. All programs and travel expenses related to youth ministry will be covered by HCC.

The Youth Director's main role is to speak or make sure that there is a speaker and worship leader on Friday evenings for the youth group meetings, and that youth activities are being planned and executed. The Youth Director and committed youth group leaders should work together as a team, complement each other, and share in the workload.

Main responsibilities include:

- Coordinating and attending Friday evening youth group (scheduling or leading the following: speakers, worship time, prayer time, sermon/Bible lessons, games);
- Development of potential leaders within the youth group;
- Mentoring and advocating for counseling help as needed;
- Connecting with parents regarding their teens as needed;
- Regular announcements and updates to youth, parents, and church by appropriate methods;
- Coordinating the annual youth retreat and other events, such as fellowship/social events (parties, movies, etc.) and spiritual/ministry events;
- Being an affiliate member of HCC, attending church and fellowship activities regularly;
- Being an active part of and reporting to the HCC Leadership Team and pastoral ministry team;
- Meeting regularly with teens for mentoring on a one-on-one basis, men with men, women with women.

Other ministry activities have included:

- Meeting with teens for lunch at their individual schools;
- Additional training together with committed youth group leaders;
- Outreach/mission trips (i.e. Kenya trip, local orphanage visit);
- Small group discipleship;
- Youth activities (Friday or Saturdays, with the help of additional volunteers;)
- Dramas or skits for occasions such as Friday service, Christmas or Easter;
- Annual Youth-led Friday service;
- Worship and Prayer organized by youth for the annual retreat;
- Special worship/prayer evenings.
